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

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

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

#### Using the Page Setup dialog

When you create a new document, it has a default page setup that includes its paper size, orientation, and scaling. Before printing a document, use the Page Setup dialog to choose a different paper size, change the orientation of the printed pages, or reduce or enlarge the content of the pages.

1. Open the document you want to print.
2. Choose **File > Page Setup**.
3. If the paper size you'll be using is a common one (such as US Letter or A4), choose **Any Printer** from the **Format For** pop-up menu. This ensures that your document can print on any printer that supports the paper size you select.  
If the paper size is specific to a certain printer, choose the printer's name from the **Format For** pop-up menu.
4. Choose the paper size you are using from the **Paper Size** pop-up menu. To create a custom paper size, choose **Manage Custom Sizes** from the **Paper Size** pop-up menu.
5. Click to select portrait (vertical) or landscape (horizontal) orientation.
6. Type the percentage you want to reduce or enlarge the printout in the **Scale** text box.
7. Click **OK**.

When you print, you'll see additional options for controlling the appearance of your document in the **Print** dialog.

If you need to scale a document because it's for paper that's a different size from the paper you have, use the "Scale to fit paper size" option in the **Print** dialog. For example, this option can automatically scale an A4 document to fit on 8 1/2 by 11 inch paper. Open the document, choose **File > Print**, choose **Paper Handling** from the **Copies & Pages** pop-up menu, and use the "Scale to fit paper size" option.
