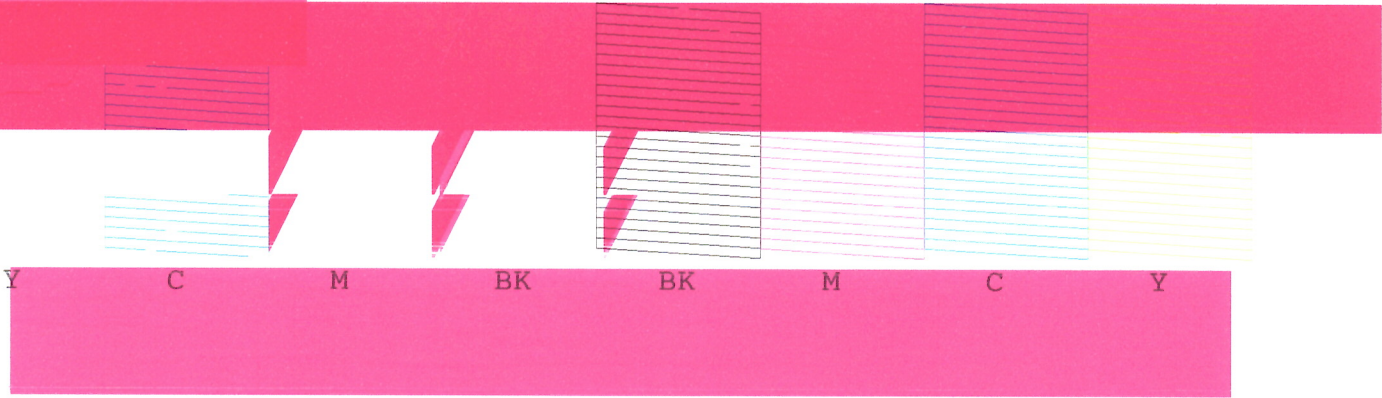




Nozzle check result

Hi everyone,

My Epson WorkForce Pro WF-4630 has worked flawlessly for 10 years, but now started to print big streaks.

Symptom :

When printing in black-white mode, I get magenta strikes.

I have already done the following, but none of them to any avail :

Epson cleaning procedure (from printer menu)

Epson outlining procedure (from printer menu)

I have cautiously manually cleaned the surface of the flushing head (where the T6710 maintenance box is inserted).

Question :

Before I start looking for a replacement printer (which I would like to avoid since scanning, emailing, still works fine),

I would appreciate any advice if anyone has experienced the same.

Probably a clogged printerhead, or would there be a real defect ?

For what I can see, the printerhead carriage is not accessible, so I am not sure what else I can do to clean without risk of damaging the printerhead.

Maybe it is possible to disable color printing mode at all, since I only use black-white printing.
